This informative and in–depth program introduces participants to the opportunites and challenges in our community, while exposing them to the Chamber's strategic initiatives and goals. Leadership Columbia provides a unique networking opportunity within a leadership training program specific to Columbia that truly is a gateway to leadership opportunities within the community.

Those selected are required to fully participate in the 15-sessions and activities which includes panel discussions, tours, hands-on experience, one-on-one interaction with current community leaders, and leadership building group activities specifically designed to expose participants to all aspects of the topics covered in each session. If your schedule does not allow for full participation, consider applying for Leadership Columbia in 2019 so that you can take full advantage of the incredible opportunities offered.

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The Selection Process

Each potential participant must submit a completed application, resume and a tuition payment for \$800 to be considered for the program. Scholarships are available (please see application for more details). Completed applications and tuition payments must be received by the Columbia Chamber of Commerce by FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2017, 5 p.m. If you are not selected for admission to the 2018 Leadership Columbia Class, your tuition will be refunded in full.

Each application is reviewed by a selection committee looking at individual qualifications and a broad spectrum of experience and background. Applicants will be notified of their acceptance into the program by **November 8, 2017**. At that time, participants will be required to submit a current professional photograph to be used throughout the program and will receive their finalized 2018 schedule.

Selection for Leadership Columbia is based on the following criteria: Involvement in professional and/or managerial positions | Demonstrated ability and desire to assume greater community leadership responsibility | Clear willingness to make a commitment to the community in subsequent years | Proof of the full support of the organization or business they represent.
