Are you an essential worker going into homes?

We recommend you ask these *three* questions to protect your health

Is anyone in the household is currently sick? (doesn't matter what the

illness is).

If so:

- Do not enter the household
- Wait to enter until everyone is well and the home has been disinfected.

Is anyone in the household is currently in quarantine? (meaning they were told by the health department to stay home because they were a close contact to someone who has the virus, they recently returned from somewhere with community transmission, or they have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting their results).

If so:

- Do not enter the household.
- Wait to enter until the quarantine has been lifted and the home has been disinfected (generally 14 days).

Is anyone in the household is in self-isolation? (meaning that they have active COVID-19).

If so:

- Do not enter the household
- Wait until self-isolation has been lifted meaning the household member has been told by the health department that they are no longer contagious, and the house has been disinfected (time varies, but a minimum of 7 days).
