In order to be considered as a Chamber of Commerce Ambassador the Ambassador nominee must agree with the following statements:

I realize that becoming a Chamber of Commerce Ambassador is an honor and I will do my best to represent both the Ambassadors and my organization by introducing myself to the business that is hosting the ribbon cutting and/or ground-breaking.

I realize that I must be respectful and polite to any business while representing the Chamber of Commerce Ambassadors.

I realize that I must maintain a Chamber Representative Status for my company in order to remain an Ambassador. I realize that I am responsible for the initial Ambassador Dues investment of \$325 which covers the cost of my gold jacket, name badge and partial year dues, and thereafter the annual dues of \$95 billed in April.

I realize this is a 100% volunteer organization and will obtain a minimum of 30 points within a year to remain active and will attend as many ribbon cuttings and/or ground breakings as my employer and my schedule allows.

I realize that attending ribbon cuttings and/or ground breakings are how we welcome or congratulate people in our community. I will do my best to show support to these businesses.

I realize that once I receive my gold jacket and name tag that I will wear this anytime I attend a ribbon cutting and/or ground breakings. If my jacket is not available, I will wear something appropriate.

I realize it is important to attend the Ambassador Quarterly Meetings and will do my best to be there as my employer and my schedule allows.
